



**INTERNATIONAL TOURNAMENT  
„BALTIC CUP 2012”  
FOR JUNIOR AND YOUTH TEAMS  
(Boys & Girls)**

**Pärnu, Estonia  
26 – 28 October 2012**

**REGULATIONS**

**1. PURPOSE AND AIM**

- 1.1. To promote the volleyball between teams of the Junior and Youth age;
- 1.2. To improve level of mentioned teams of age for preparing to the forthcoming European and Eastern European Volleyball Zonal Association Championships.

**2 .BODIES RESPONSIBLE**

- 2.1. International Tournament “Baltic Cup 2012” will be organized by Volleyball Federation of Estonia.

**3. COMPETITION DATES AND VENUE**

- 3.1. International Tournament “Baltic Cup 2012” will take place in Pärnu (Estonia) from 26<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> October 2012.

Arrival: 26<sup>th</sup> October 2012

Competitions: 26<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> October 2012

Departure 28<sup>th</sup> October 2012

- 3.2. The competition will take place in **Pärnu Sports Hall, Riia mnt 129 and in Pärnu Central School Sports Hall (Kuninga 29)**.

**4. RIGHT OF PARTICIPATION OF PLAYERS**

- 4.1. Players wishing to participate shall be aged as follows:  
**Junior, Group A**, boys, born 1995/1996; girls, born 1996/1997

## **Youth, Group B, boys, born 1997/1998; girls born 1998/1999**

4.2. The following National teams will participate, Latvia, Lithuania, Estonia, other invited teams by Organizer.

4.3. Composition of the teams: Each team will consist of 14 persons – 12 players, 2 coaches.

4.4. The composition of each delegation per country is 4 teams and the 1 head of delegation.

## **5.RULES**

5.1. Competitions shall be organized and played under the Official Volleyball Rules laid down by the FIVB. No technical time-outs will be used during the matches.

## **6. BALLS**

The official ball of the competition is MIKASA MVA200.

## **7.COMPETITION FORMAT**

7.1. Competition will be played according the single Round robin system – each team will play against other.

### **7.2. ALLOCATION OF POINTS AND CLASSIFICATION**

7.2.1. The ranking of teams is determined by the points awarded for matches won and lost.

7.2.2 Points awarded per match to each team:

- Winner 3:0 or 3:1 3 points
- Winner 3:2 2 points
- Loser 2:3 1 point
- Loser 1:3 or 0:3 0 point

7.2.3 In case of equality in the number of points gained by two or several teams, they will be classified in descending order by the number of the matches won.

7.2.4 If the tie persists, as per number of matches won, they will be classified in descending order by the set quotient resulting from the division of the number of all sets won by the number of all sets lost.

7.2.5 If the tie persists, as per the set quotient, they will be classified in descending order by the set points quotient resulting from the division of all set points scored by the total of set points lost during all sets.

7.2.6 If the tie continues, as per the sets points quotient, the teams are ranked according to the result(s) of the match(es), which the teams have disputed between them.

7.2.7. A match will be accounted for as lost by 0-3 (0-25; 0-25; 0-25) by the team concerned, if a team doesn't register for the game.

## **8. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS**

8.1. All travel expenses will be covered by concerned federations of participating teams.

8.2. Volleyball Federation of Estonia will cover accommodation and meals of Lithuanian, Latvian, Estonian teams and all organizing expenses (sport hall, referees etc.) as well.

The conditions for invited teams are settled between involved Federations.

## 9. REGISTRATION AND DEADLINES

9.1. Each participating team for participating in the competition has to be registered in a set deadline till **17<sup>th</sup> October 2012** by the Official registration form **BC-05 FORM**. This form has to be sent to Volleyball federation of Estonia. **BC-05 Bis FORM** has to be sent to Organizer till **24<sup>th</sup> October 2012**. The originals of the Registration forms must be presented to the Referee Delegate of the tournament on the very first day of the competition (during the Technical Meeting).

9.2. BC-05 FORM, signed by President/Secretary General of concerned federation, is the official confirmation of health conditions compliance of each player to take part in competition. In case of wrong data, mentioned in **BC-05/05 bis FORMS**, its becomes to responsibility of concerned federation.

## 10. PRIZE OF HONOUR

The team carrying off the title of **TOURNAMENT** shall receive a cup as well as a Diploma from Organizing National Federation. All the players having taken part, as well as the other 2 members of the delegation, shall receive gold medals from the organizing National Federation.

A total of 14 medals must be produced for the team.

### TEAMS CLASSIFIED 2ND & 3RD

The teams classified second and third shall receive cups as well as a diploma from the Organizing National Federation.

All the players having taken part, as well as the other 2 members of the delegation, shall receive respectively silver and bronze medals as well as a diploma from the organizing National Federation. The medals are provided by the Organizing National Federation.

Four best players in each age group will be awarded with an individual prizes.
